

THE ORGAN OF HOLY TRINITY ANGLICAN CHURCH SURREY HILLS

The present organ was rebuilt and installed by Australian Pipe Organs (APO) in 1999, and an opening recital was given by John Mallinson in August. The organ was based on a Norman and Beard Ltd (N&B) instrument from St Joseph's Roman Catholic Church, Edgecliff, Sydney, of 14 stops, built in 1912 and rebuilt by George Fincham P/L in 1973. This was combined with parts of the previous organ in the church by Bellsham (B), as well as other ranks from APO and Fincham (F), to complete the specification. The organ consists of two manuals and pedals, 25 stops with approximately 1,350 pipes, and employs electro-pneumatic action and solid-state switching. In 2025, a Swell Oboe 8 was made available, and a Great Flute 4 was added.

The stop list of the organ is provided below, along with the origins of the pipe work.
